How to find low-cost health care in Bennington County

2. Call the hospital or health clinic if you have questions.

3. Fill out an application and send it to the hospital or health clinic.

Eligibility

- Free Care: You may qualify for free care (pay \$0) if your income is under <u>250% of the</u> Federal Poverty Level (FPL).
- Low-Cost Care: You may qualify for a 75% discount if your household income is below 400% FPL.
- **Resources:** The hospital may deny your application if your household's total liquid resources are more than <u>400% FPL</u> for your household size. Liquid resources are things like cash and money in savings and checking accounts. (Your main home and cars and money held in retirement accounts will **not** count against you.)
